#### **Announcement**

The Environmental Sciences Research Network (ESRN) of the University of Vienna aims at bringing together researchers from various disciplines – from social sciences and the humanities to natural sciences – to jointly develop new perspectives and creative ideas for future environmental research. In summer 2017 the ESRN organises a postdoc retreat in order to build bridges across the postdoctoral community in environmental sciences. The overall goal is to provide young researchers from the ESRN member institutions with opportunities to network, to sensitize for interdisciplinary research approaches and to encourage exchange and communication, including guidance in science communication.
