## Power, Interaction, Exclusion

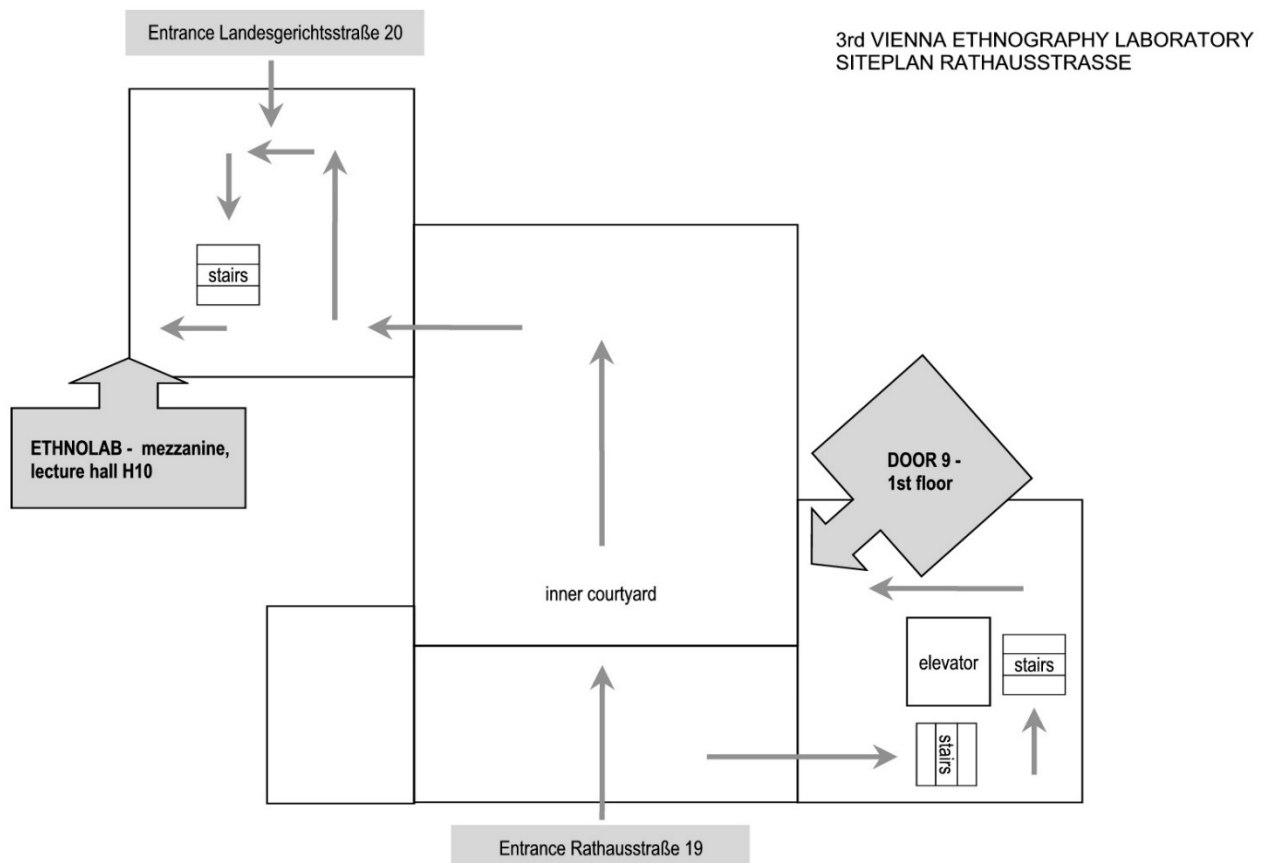
3rd Vienna Ethnography Laboratory, 9. – 11. June 2016
